All review and reflective papers in this journal have undergone editorial screening and double-blind peer review.

Publication Frequency: Generally, JSRH is published two times a year, in June and December of each year.

Article Processing Charges: JSRH does not charge authors or any third party for publication. Both submission and processing of manuscripts, and publication of articles are free of charge. There are no fees for publishing materials. There are no: "article processing charges" (APCs), "article submission charges", "membership fees" or "language editing fees". We do not charge authors for having color photos or extra pages in their articles. There are no hidden costs whatsoever.
